The impact of agricultural exposures upon women working and living on farms remains relatively unexplored outside of pesticide exposures, while the number of women active in farming is increasing. The series of papers by Fenton et al. surveying Pennsylvania dairy farm women assesses the potential impact of zoonotic exposures and provides insight into the occupational practices and safety perception of the respondents.
