Volunteer Services will help you identify a fit within one of our many opportunities including, but not limited to:

Coffee Kiosk – An engaging opportunity while enjoying the smell of Starbucks. A special treat is warranted in a hospital setting, and you can help uplift someone's energy and day. Staff who work 12 hour shifts highly appreciate this service. Learn how to make specialty coffee drinks and teas, reward people with our coffee cards, offer a breakaway, pleasant setting for staff and visitors, facilitate transactions, and support opening/closing and ongoing cleaning functions.

Escort/Information Specialist – A supportive opportunity to help patients and visitors. Guide patients to check-in and escort patients/visitors to appropriate departments, hospital floors, or meeting locations. Offer wheelchair transportation. Deliver flowers, cards and patient mail. Maintain confidential information to support patients and visiting families.

Gift Shop – A role for those with an eye for nice gifts, supporting staff, visitors, and patients. Offer guidance regarding product options for visitors and staff seeking to uplift a loved one's spirits or treat themselves. Provide a breakaway, pleasant setting, facilitate accurate transaction, assist with product labels and display maintenance, and support opening/closing functions.

Pet Therapy – A role to provide pet therapy (dogs only) visits to patients and family members in waiting areas or patient rooms at a mutually agreed upon time. Must be TDI Competency Validated.

Surgical Waiting – A gratifying morning or afternoon shift serving patients and families. Assist checking in patients who will be having surgery and gather contact details for loved ones. Guide family members back to patients in the bay areas. Serve as a liaison between surgical services staff and family members to provide important updates.
