

Marshfield Medical Center in Marshfield

Marshfield Medical Center is a tertiary referral center providing advanced level care for patients in Marshfield area communities and from around the Marshfield Clinic Health System service area. Marshfield Medical Center is a Level II Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center and has northern and central Wisconsin's only children's hospital. The campus includes 314 inpatient beds and a wide range of outpatient services.

The medical center provides 24/7 emergency department access, adult and pediatric inpatient rehabilitation programs, primary care, birth center, cancer care and research, critical care transport, imaging and lab services, pharmacy, physical and occupational therapy, sleep medicine, specialty surgical services, hyperbaric oxygen therapy chamber, a program providing advanced-care life support using ECMO (extracorporeal membrane oxygenation) technology, graduate medical programs and is home to Marshfield Clinic Research Institute.

The Health System's network of care in the region includes primary care clinics in Colby and Stratford.
