Households with a child in preschool-college can qualify. Call Spectrum at 855-707-7328 and ask for the free internet for students affected by school closures due to COVID-19. Households may receive up to 2 months of free service. If they do not cancel services before the 3 rd month begins, they will be charged the promotional new customer rate of \$49.99/month. Free internet services are available at standard speeds. High speeds are not available. There is no installation fee. Services are available everywhere that Spectrum provides regular internet services.
KwikTrip Delivery for Essentials	<p>Kwik Trip announced they are offering free delivery through EatStreet to help people get essential items.</p> <p>There are over 70 Kwik Trips in Wisconsin that offer delivery via KwikTrip will waive delivery fees on order of eight dollars or more on food and essential items such as eggs, bread and toilet paper.</p> <p>Beer, liquor, and tobacco products are not included in the deal.</p>
